Insurance

If you are a guest researcher and have no contract with Aalborg University, it is recommended that you take out personal liability insurance in Denmark while working at CNAP. If you do not have an employment contract with Aalborg University and do human experiments, you can only be involved in laboratory work according to protocols approved by the ethics committee.

Contact to Authorities

In order to ensure consistency in external communication with Danish authorities (e.g. ethics committees, the Danish Health and Medicine Authorities, the Danish Medicine Agency, the Data Protection Agency, municipalities, regions, etc.), *all* such contacts *have to* be approved by either your RIG head, your supervisor, or the SMI secretariat.

Transfer of Research Results

Upon termination of your employment/end of your research stay at CNAP you are obliged to transfer all data and results of your research to CNAP. The data and results should be transferred to your immediate superior.
